## ROCO 2005 Willamette Valley Pinot Noir

### Wine Advocate Review - 92 Points



*The 2005 Pinot Noir is a blend of several vineyards. It offers an excellent nose of pain grille, cinnamon, rose petal, cassis, and black cherry. This leads to a rich, layered wine with more baby fat than is typical in 2005. The wine has lots of guts, with plenty of depth, concentration, and a long, pure finish. Cellar it for 3-5 years and drink it through 2025. ROCO Wine Cellar is owned and operated by Rollin and Corby Soles and includes their 7-acre Wit's End Vineyard. Rollin Soles has been the winemaker at Argyle Winery since 1987. Drink 2010-2025*

*Smooth, velvety and generous with its black cherry and sage flavors, wrapped nicely in a soft cloak of fine tannins as the finish rolls on. Has presence and grace. Drink now through 2012. - Harvey Steiman*
