“The 2015 Pinot Noir Ancient Water comes from a blend of grapes, all planted on sedimentary stone-derived soils. It’s pale to medium ruby-purple in color with a nose of cranberry sauce, red cherry jam and raspberry preserves with touches of cardamom, warm earth, dried leaves and potpourri. Light to medium-bodied, it fills the mouth with concentrated red and black fruits, spice and earth, with fine, grainy tannins and juicy acidity, finishing very long and spicy.”
