
2016 Gravel Road Pinot Noir

Tasting Notes by Winemaker, Rollin Soles



Layers of aromas include black cherry and currants shifting toward sour cherry and red cherry, intermingled with spiced aromatics of German Chocolate Cake and black pepper overlaying a foundation of fresh, fall forest floor earth. The flavor is immediately generous, round with lovely mid-palate weight. Look for those black fruits and a raspberry crème liquor fruitiness at the finish. White peppercorn and nasturtium seed blend with deeper chocolate and vanilla spices. Luscious Pinot noir from start, to round middle, to a very long, vibrant finish. This pinot is enjoyable today and is well worth aging for up to 10 years.
