ROCO Winery is a leading creator of high quality, small production wine in the Willamette Valley. ROCO is the embodiment of Rollin Soles' innovative winemaking practices and Corby Soles' vision to produce the finest Pinot Noir, Chardonnay and Sparkling Wine in Oregon. ROCO's family owned, sustainably farmed vineyards ensure the highest quality of wine.

## KEY SELLING POINTS

- Rollin Soles, founder and former winemaker for Argyle Winery, has been making wine in the Willamette Valley for nearly 40 years.
- Rollin is the only winemaker to have made the *Wine Spectator's* Top 100 with red, sparkling and white wines. With more top wines than any other Oregon winemaker, and named one of the most "20 Admired Winemakers" in *Vineyard & Winery Management Magazine*, 2014.
- The fruit is sourced from premier vineyards in the Willamette Valley, Knudsen, Marsh Estate and the Soles' own Wits' End Vineyards. These vineyards are low yield, high quality, LIVE certified sustainable and Salmon Safe.
- ROCO takes an intimate and artisanal approach to winemaking. First, the fruit is coldroom chilled and undergoes whole berry de-stemming. The small lots then ferment in open top bins before spending a full 18 months in barrel.
