"Set in the Dundee Hills, the esteemed Knudsen Vineyard sits on Jory soil, red clay as well as volcanic basalt. This Pinot Noir opens with feminine aromas of rose petals, red cherry, red raspberry and crushed gravel. There are rich flavors of wild mushroom risotto, red cherry, cran-pomegranate and wet stone.
